
Eiscover Westhaven's 20 Parks



DISCOVERY PARK: As you drive into the community on Westhaven Boulevard, you will see Discovery Park on the right. This passive park is surrounded by a paved mulit-prupose path and is a perfect setting for a picnic, a pickup game of soccer, or flying a kite.

FOUNDERS SQUARE (THE FOUNTAIN): This beautiful park is home to the most iconic landmark in Westhaven. The key feature is the fountain, which is a replica of the fountain located in Savannah Georgia's Forsythe Park. The pavers surrounding the fountain are engraved with the names of the 100 founding homeowners. Founders' Square is used for informal gatherings, picnics, live music events, plant sales, and is the backdrop for countless photo shoots.

- GAGA PARK & CAMPFIRE HOLLOW: This area includes a small playground, a wood-burning fire pit, and a gaga court. Gaga is a variation of dodgeball that is a popular children's game.
- BOYD MILL TRAIL & PLAYGROUND: This section of the multi-purpose path stretches along Old Boyd Mill Pike. Lined with stacked stone walls, this is a great place to walk your dog, ride our bike or play on the playground.
- WESTHAVEN GOLF CLUB: Westhaven features a private, PGA certified, 18-hole golf course. You will always be greeted with a smile, and you will never have enough of the food.
- SUNSET PARK: This large lawn, complimented by benches and beautiful landscaping, is great for a game of frisbee or just a relaxed day in the sun. This new park has already hosted an outdoor music, live music during Porchfest, and a new neighbor meet and greet. And, it is one of the best sunset views in the community.

WESTHAVEN HIKING TRAILS: This may be the best kept secret in Westhaven. Three trails, Randy's Ridge, East Slope Trail, and West Slope Trail, make up this beautiful, challenging network of hiking trails. The coolest part is that the trail is maintained by volunteer homeowners.

- ARDMORE PARK: Referred to as "Cigar Park" in early days due to its shape, this passive park is one of the many beautifully kept common areas. With benches and detailed horticulture, this park is an example of the details Westhaven is known for.
- PROSPECT PARK: This pocket park is a small grassy null perfect for kids and dogs.
 - THE GREAT LAWN: This event lawn is located directly behind the Westhaven Residents' Club. It is an ideal location for the summer concert series, private parties, weddings, outdoor movies, or a game of pick up soccer during break time at the pool.
- TOWNSEND GREEN: Located directly across from the Resident's Club, Townsend Green is perfect for a cornhole tournament, hosting annual 5K's, Easter egg hunts, or getting the kids together for some soccer.
- PEARL STREET PARK: This long, narrow, tree-lined park is known for it's mature trees, great multipurpose path, babbling brook, fishing pond, and playground. This park hosts most block parties and the annual Halloween festivities.
- **PEARRE SPRINGS POND:** This fishing pond neighbors the Pearl Street Park across Townsend Boulevard. It features great fishing and a lovely path to the pickleball courts.

- to enjoy this park. A life size chess set, bocce ball court, seating, and large grassy area make it a perfect place to hang out on a nice day.
- crossroads park: The neighboring homeowners affectionately refer to this as Popsicle Park because of all the kids' summer gatherings. It is a nice grassy area that is home to small gatherings and outdoor games and activities.
- GIVING TREE PARK: This corner park has two mature trees that provide a swing, picnic area, and a shaded bench dedicated to Patricia Peel.
 - ST. JUDE DREAM PARK: This passive park sits directly across from an undeveloped section of Westhaven and creates a beautiful little haven for families to play and enjoy.
 - THE ROCK POND: The Rock Pond is unique because of its large boulder like rocks. With water in it all year round, the geese are spotted often enjoying the quiet nature. A long multipurpose path extends past the pond where you can enjoy the mature trees and maybe a fairy village if you are lucky.
